Dr. Richard Miron is currently lead educator and researcher at Advanced PRF Education and an Adjunct Visiting Faculty in the department of Periodontology in Bern, Switzerland, where he completed his PhD studies since 2009. He has currently published over 350 peer-reviewed articles and lectures internationally on many topics relating to growth factors, bone biomaterials and guided bone regeneration. For the past eight years, Dr. Miron



has been recognized by Dentistry Today as being one of the top 100 CE providers in the country and the youngest to ever make the list. He is also the top ranked researcher on Platelet-Rich Fibrin therapy as per Expertscape independent review. He has recently been awarded many international prizes in dentistry and is widely considered as one of the top contributors to implant dentistry having won the ITI Andre Schroeder Prize, the IADR Young Investigator of the Year in the field of Implant Dentistry as well as the IADR Socransky Research award in the field of Periodontology (2020). He has written eleven textbooks widely distributed in regenerative dentistry including his best-seller in 2019 titled: "Next Generation Biomaterials for Bone and Periodontal Regeneration", in 2021 titled: "Understanding Platelet Rich Fibrin" and in 2023 titled: "Modern Implant Dentistry".

Shaun Fix has been practicing and teaching in the hospital and pre-hospital fields since 1983. As the president of Emergency Medical Consultants, Inc., his team provides CE programs to over 15,000 professionals annually. Shaun spent 36 years practicing in pre-hospital emergency medicine, the last 30 of which he served as a company officer in charge of EMS at Boca Raton Fire Rescue Services in South Florida.



Since the 1990s, Shaun and his team have been delivering Management of Office Emergencies for Dental Professionals and Dental Specialty ACLS and PALS courses. They also were involved in developing the original Dental Airway Course curriculum alongside members of the FSOMS board.

Shaun has presented at state, national, and international conferences and has been featured on FETN, Pulse, 24-7 EMS, Medic Monthly, and Emergency Medical Update videos. A frequent lecturer, author, and consultant, he and his team are known for keeping their programs engaging, practical, and tailored to the specific needs of healthcare providers, bringing "the reality of emergency medicine" into the classroom.

We would like to provide clarification on the hands-on portion of our summer meeting. Dr. Miron will be bringing his PRF team for the event. It will be quite comprehensive, as he would with any of his courses. The hands-on stations will include: (1) Phlebotomy, (2) Dental PRF applications, (3) BioHeat and liquid PRF facial/lip fillers, (4) PRF microneedling, and (5) Exosomal injections. The training will be set up in stations that FAP members and their teams can freely move to and from, allowing them the flexibility to acquire as much or as little experience in each workstation as they desire.

Additionally, the FAP members should know that Dr. Miron will be providing the doctors and assistants the opportunity for Florida (and National) licensure in Phlebotomy should they choose to do the additional coursework. **Please see this message from Dr. Richard Miron below:**

During the meeting, I will be bringing Jose Lopez, one of my nurses that is also a National Phlebotomy Instructor that will be able to provide licensures to any assistant in attendance. You read that right, we will be able to provide the dental assistants of any periodontist in attendance with a Florida (and National) state licensure to perform phlebotomy!

The program works in 3 steps.

- An 8 hour of training day must be completed. That will be the Saturday during both the didactic and hands-on Session.
- They must take our online training. In it, they will need to download a form and complete 30 blood draws under the guidance of a doctor at their own leisure. They can do this both prior to or after the FAP.
- Once the 30 sticks has been completed, then they will submit that sheet to Jose, and he will send them to take the National Online Exam. It is 100 questions over 2 hours, it can be taken anytime from any computer. We've never had anyone fail. It's a sure bet to getting your license to be able to perform phlebotomy legally. The program is typically \$995 but we will be offering a half price discount and that weekend only, the cost will be \$495.

Trust me when I say this, we've never made the price that low ever. There are significant costs that we have to the National Phlebotomy Services (NPS) but I am doing this to help out the academy. Here is a small synopsis of the online training below. Can't wait to see you in a few short months.

Most traditional phlebotomy courses mainly prepare students for work in blood labs like Quest Diagnostics. They cover test protocols, tube types, and the order in which to draw blood. However, they often leave students ill-equipped to confidently perform PRF production, which is often their primary goal.
