**MAKE PERIO
GREAT AGAIN**

Now that I have your attention due to this political year, I think the above title is a great way to start my last president's message. It's been an interesting year for our country and our profession. It seems like our specialty, as well as all other dental specialties have been pushed aside for a super generalist model of teaching in our dental schools, especially the for-profit model schools. The American Dental Association (ADA) which represents all of dentistry voted for Resolution #65 at the last ADA House of Delegates meeting. This resolution, an amendment to the ADA Code of Ethics states, "A dentist may ethically announce as a specialist to the public in any of the dental specialties recognized by the ADA and in any other areas of dentistry for which specialty recognition has been granted....." (visit the ADA website to read the entire resolution). What was the reason behind this resolution and why wasn't there a fight? Well, that decision was already won in court with the lawsuit brought by the American Board of Dental Specialties and the ADA was just cleaning up language to match that decision. This decision affects all specialties, not just periodontics.

So, what does that mean going forward? It means that we need to work harder in the dental school clinics to continue to have a presence with the students. We must show how we, as a specialty, can enhance the treatment of their patients and form teams for treatment. We have to be able to show the benefits and successes of working in teams in both treatment and in case planning. In light of this, our February meeting features Dr. Brody Hildebrand, a board- certified Orthodontist and Prosthodontist as our keynote speaker. He will discuss how working in teams help, not only the practitioner, but also the patient themselves.

Pay FAP 2017 Membership Dues



The Florida Board of Dentistry (BOD) met in Miami on Friday, November 18, 2016. Nine of the eleven BOD members were present. The consumer member was absent. There is one position (consumer) open that has yet to be filled by the Governor.

At the beginning of the meeting, Dr. Robert Perdomo, received public recognition for his years of service to the BOD. This was his last meeting as Chair and he has termed out.

The BOD heard a presentation from Dr. David Perkins, DMD, Chairman of the Commission on Dental Competency and Assessments (CDCA). He gave a brief overview of the CDCA and the ADEX exam. He stated that all exams are not equal and that ADEX is the most comprehensive. The CDCA is encouraging all state boards to use the ADEX exam as their licensure exam. BOD staff will work with staff at the CDCA to ensure Florida statutes are being followed when an applicant applies to take the ADEX exam in Florida.

There was one probation appearance, one application review (applying for a temporary certificate) that was denied, and seven disciplinary cases including two voluntary relinquishments.

The BOD also reviewed a recommended order from the Division of Administrative Hearings.

After the disciplinary cases concluded, four Board members left the meeting. This resulted in the BOD losing its quorum. No business could be conducted and the BOD adjourned.

There was no vote for chair and no vote on the hygiene rules.

Implant Interactions with Orthodontics

The advent and success of implantology continues to transform dentistry, and the inclusion of implants as integral components in orthodontic mechanotherapy is a particularly interesting application. Much more than setting up cases to receive implants for tooth replacement, orthodontic techniques that actually employ implants for the purpose of anchorage has a dramatic effect on previously unattainable possibilities and outcomes. Implant-enhanced orthodontics can be achieved by a variety of means. Interdisciplinary treatment planning will be the topic of discussion throughout the day.

Course Objectives:

Upon completion of this curriculum, the participants should be able to:

1. Appreciate the application of implant technology to orthodontic therapy
2. Benefits and contraindications for use of implants in orthodontic treatments
3. Understand the advantages and utilization of direct and indirect anchorage
4. Decision points will be discussed for determining the proper time to open or close spaces related to implant restorative options
5. Interdisciplinary treatment planning techniques for developing and executing on best treatment options for complex patients

Dr. Hildebrand is a founding partner of DevRight and is instrumental in the development of educational modules for elite speaker development and social media support. He also acts as Managing Director of DevRight Corporate Affairs.
